




### Dear Parishioners

As we approach the 1 year mark since the regularity of our in-church services was disrupted, the questions now facing us liturgically are many. Research into on-line worship has elicited the following observations (and more, but space here is limited):

- Sunday worship has no time or day constraints anymore with many people tuning in on days other than Sunday.
- Holy Space is not confined to consecrated buildings but is wherever God's people are. i.e. the once Sacred/Profane distinction has evaporated.
- Parishioners will be reluctant to return to in-person church attendance as, even with the best sanitizing regimes in place, gatherings pose a potential health risk.

Among the questions it raises for us going forward are: how do we fulfill our calling as God's worshipping and witnessing people if we can't all gather together for that, our primary, purpose? How can liturgies respond worshipfully & meaningfully to constraints, fluidity of time & space and diverse theologies parishioners hold? Let's start the 'click & brick' i.e. the on-line & in-church conversation.

The 10.30am Sunday service in Church will also be available (after 24 hours)



*May you treasure your friends.*


From the hymn *The Breastplate of St Patrick*:
