Book sculpture is a craft more familiar to us through the bound olive wood book covers that we may have encountered on market stalls in the Middle East.

Between the covers are photos of significant sites or landmarks accompanied by a brief description of the historical event or person associated with the site. In this way everything in the book is interpreted for us the site/landmark itself, the history, the significance, the worthiness for selection etc. The Book of Daniel is a book sculpture currently being exhibited in the RHA. Comprising elm beams



hanging without pages, photos, script, it invites the viewer to linger and find the essence of its story - perhaps aided by knowledge of the Biblical Daniel. Somewhere in the viewing, the viewers own story percolates too. The bottom right corner is slightly curved suggesting a page being turned, or a new season about to emerge.

As we embark on Springtime and new growth, spiritually may our story of being loved by God emerge too - not just in words, but in our sense of awe and wonder at being known and loved by the Almighty One.

Garden of Remembrance

The Garden of Remembrance has added to the overall look of the Church grounds and several loved ones have been interred at this stage.

The project ran marginally over budget due to growth in global construction costs and some additions that were deemed worthwhile. The Select Vestry has decided to increase the cost of the ground-based plots, which can take 3 urns, from €2,000 up to €2,500. The increase, approved by Diocesan Councils, will come into effect from the 30th June 2023. The wall plots can only take 2 urns and the cost will remain at €2,000. Gordon Wright

In memory of Linda Gillis




