Completed in 1885 by renowned Hull organ builders Forster & Andrews, now, after almost 140 years of faithful service, it urgently requires major restoration work.

Our dream is for the organ to be completely refurbished by 2024. The work will be carried out by Carlow-based organ builder Stephen Adams, using repurposed and recycled parts where possible.

### A WORD ABOUT TAX AND CHARITABLE DONATIONS


The Charitable Donation Scheme allows tax relief on qualifying donations made to approved bodies. You can help an approved body to claim tax relief on your donation by completing an:

Enduring Certificate – CHY3 Certificate valid for a period of five years

Annual Certificate – CHY4 Certificate valid for a period of one year.
