



A 4-week online reading group: on Wednesdays May 7th-28th, 7.30-8.30pm facilitated by Jessica Brown & Catherine Smith You are warmly invited to join us!

Join the Church's Ministry of Healing: Ireland this May for Poems for Hope and Healing.

This is a slow and mindful reading group, to which everyone is warmly welcome. Each hour-long session will be an invitation to pause, reflect, and pray, and discover how reading poetry together can be a spiritual practice that helps us listen to our emotions, see the world in surprising ways, and open the doors of our own creativity.

You will receive the poems and a worksheet in advance. Each session will feature: thoughtful conversation about the poems; time for journalling and creative reflection with prompts to inspire you; gentle questions that invite spiritual exploration.
