Organ Refurbishment Project

We were delighted with the news on 7th March that the Department of Housing, Local Government and Heritage had approved a grant towards the refurbishment of the parish organ.



A grant of €15,000 from the Built Heritage Investment Scheme, as recommended by SDCC, has taken the fund total to date to €53,000, over 40% of the way to our €125,000 total only 7 months after our launch. The cost is €20 per car and there will be great prizes!


